Our vision is to be a leading distributor of cashew products, bridging the gap between local producers and global buyers, while promoting **economic empowerment** and sustainable development in West Africa.

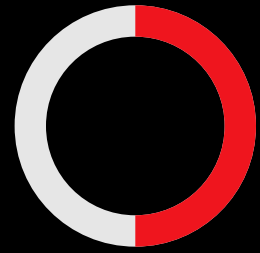

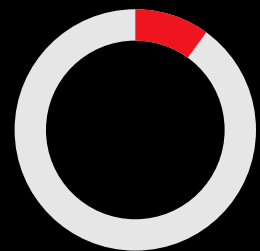

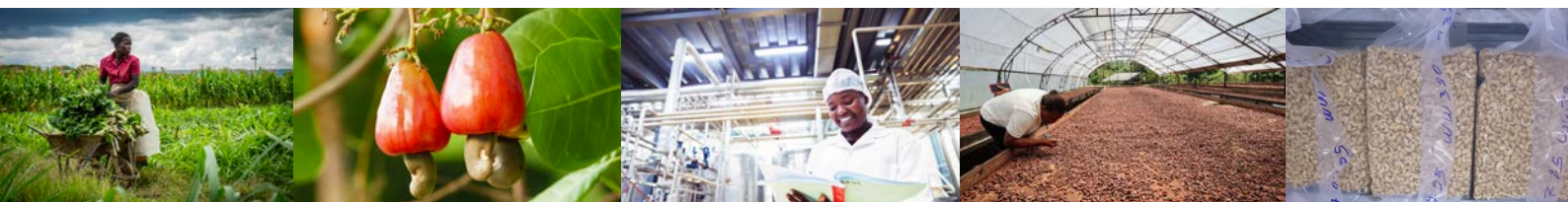

Our Certifications

1. AB (Agriculture Biologique) – France

The French organic certification ensuring products are grown and processed without synthetic chemicals, GMOs, or artificial additives. It emphasizes sustainable farming practices and environmental protection.

2. EU Organic (Euro Leaf)

The official European Union organic label. It guarantees compliance with EU organic farming regulations, covering production, processing, distribution, and labeling across all EU countries.

3. Bio Suisse Organic

A Swiss organic standard that is stricter than EU organic regulations. It ensures products are sustainably produced, environmentally friendly, and socially responsible, with full traceability.

4. USDA Organic

The U.S. Department of Agriculture certification ensuring crops and food products meet strict organic standards, including non-GMO, no synthetic pesticides, and sustainable farming practices.

5. Fairtrade International

A certification promoting fair wages, safe working conditions, and sustainable livelihoods for farmers and workers in developing countries. It also supports ethical trade and community development.

6. HACCP (Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points)

An internationally recognized system for food safety. It identifies, evaluates, and controls hazards in food production to ensure safe consumption.

7. BRCGS Food Safety (British Retail Consortium Global Standard)

A leading global standard for food safety management. It ensures products are manufactured, prepared, and handled according to the highest quality and safety requirements.

8. SMETA (Sedex Members Ethical Trade Audit)

An ethical audit methodology assessing responsible business practices, including labor rights, health and safety, environment, and business integrity within supply chains.
